

Rio de Janeiro, Brazil

Enjoy your floating hotel on Saturday and sail from Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, on Sunday at 9pm. Described by Darwin as "more magnificent than anything any European has ever seen in his country of origin," Rio is blessed with an idyllic setting. Lying on Brazil's Atlantic coast close to the Tropic of Capricorn, Rio boasts magnificent beaches set against a mountainous backdrop. In contrast to its tranquil setting, Rio is home to Carnaval, a five-day celebration that makes Mardi Gras seem timid by comparison. For those interested in sunbathing and people-watching, the beaches of Ipanema and Copacabana provide an ideal spot.

Búzios, Brazil

From 8am to 9pm, discover Búzios, Brazil. Originally settled by European pirates and slave traders, this picturesque fishing village is now decidedly chic. Unheard of until Brigitte Bardot was photographed sashaying barefoot along the beach in 1964, it was suddenly all the rage. Surrounded by hills draped in luxuriant vegetation, this "paradise found" is a high-end resort with international flair. More than 20 beaches beckon sun-worshippers and water-sports enthusiasts, and the sophisticated boutiques of Rua das Pedras will delight shoppers. Brigitte in bronze greets you on the seaside promenade.

From 11am to 11pm, enjoy Parati, Brazil. The small coastal village of Parati is a virtual museum within a tropical paradise. An old mining town, Parati is full of beautifully restored, classical 18th-century Portuguese buildings. Although Parati still retains quite a bit of small-town charm (no cars are allowed), sophisticated tourists are beginning to flock to it for sunshine and spectacular beaches.

From 7am to 4pm, explore Ilhabela, Brazil. This "beautiful island" lives up to its name, and today it belies its once lurid reputation as a hideout for smugglers and pirates. Where failed coffee plantations replaced lush vegetation, the land has been reclaimed, and state park trails provide access to a luscious green jungle and numerous waterfalls where you can stop for a swim. Divers will find great opportunities on some of the many shipwrecks off the coast. And when you work up an appetite there is nothing better than shrimp right off the boat, accompanied by Brazil's national cocktail, the caipirinha.

Punta del Este, **Uruguay**

From 7:30am to 5pm visit Punta del Este, Uruguay. Known as the St. Tropez of Latin America, Punta del Este is a favorite summer playground of the rich and famous of southernmost South America, with a pristine



20-mile shoreline offering two distinctly different types of beaches. Big waves beckon surfers at La Brava, while calmer waters create ideal conditions for sailing or just plain relaxing at La Mansa.

Buenos Aires, Argentina

From 8am on Sunday to disembarkation on Monday, discover Buenos Aires, Argentina. Birthplace of the tango and known as the Paris of the South, this cosmopolitan business center is rich in charm and culture. There are opera houses, museums and cathedrals that rival any in Europe. Puerto Madero, the city's oldest port, has been transformed into a vibrant restaurant and boutique center






AZAMARA JOURNEY® DECK PLANS




