Situated at the foot of Deer Mountain, Ketchikan is backed by steep, forested slopes and fringed by a pristine waterfront, creating an impossibly beautiful backdrop. Not far in the distance is the Tongass National Forest—the nation's largest, abundant with wildlife and the peaceful aura of the North Country.
