PORTS OF CALL

SORRENTO/CAPRI, ITALY

Overlooking the breathtaking Bay of Naples and near the legendary ruins of Pompeii, Sorrento charms with cobblestone streets, a seaside promenade and vibrant Southern Italian culture. According to Greek mythology, here was the home of the Sirens, the femmes fatales who lured sailors to rocky shores. AMALFI/POSITANO, ITALY

Straddled by the glamorous cities of Cannes and Nice, the town boasts its own distinct charm and the best natural sand beaches on the French Riviera.

BARCELONA, SPAIN

Harbored on the Mediterranean, Barcelona claims a world of its own, where posh sophistication lives harmoniously with historic tradition, and striking architecture clings to plush hills. The city's spirited energy gave inspiration to the artistic masterminds of Antonio Gaudí and Picasso. The ever-evolving Sagrada Familia, bustling open-air markets, and grid-like streets of Eixample give distinction to every inch of the city, while the mysterious passages of Barrio Gotic are home to the most comprehensive medieval quarter in Europe.
