

Berlin (Warnemünde), Germany

One of Europe's liveliest capitals, Berlin is brimming with cultural landmarks. The grand neoclassical Brandenburg Gate opens onto Unter den Linden, the city's famed tree-lined boulevard that paves the way to the historical heart of Berlin, and weathered remnants of the iconic Berlin Wall recall the city's storied past.
