PORTS OF CALL

Berlin (Warnemünde), Germany

One of Europe's liveliest capitals, Berlin is brimming with cultural landmarks. The grand neoclassical Brandenburg Gate opens onto Unter den Linden, the city's famed tree-lined boulevard that paves the way to the historical heart of Berlin, and weathered remnants of the iconic Berlin Wall recall the city's storied past. The port of Warnemünde also delights with its lovely Gothic churches, market square and seaside promenade.

Klaipeda, Lithuania

Originally founded as a fortress in the 13th century; held at times under Prussian, Swedish, Russian and German rule; and currently the third-largest city in Lithuania, Klaipeda claims a truly fascinating and complex history. Scattered remnants can be found in the Old Town, where a single surviving tower of a once glorious red-brick castle remains.

Riga, Latvia

Cobbled medieval streets, spacious parks and a historic Old Town that's a UNESCO World Heritage Site, bring a timeless feel to the ever-evolving fairy-tale city of Riga. Once dubbed the "Paris of the East," the capital of Latvia is today a vibrant metropolis and the largest city in the Baltics.

Helsinki, Finland

Dynamic and captivating, Helsinki is renowned as an international design mecca, where innovative architecture overlooks spacious green parks and open-air markets. Harbor cruises float past a breathtaking backdrop of forests and villas, while the celebrated Suomenlinna, a ruined fortification spanning five islands, enchants its visitors.

St. Petersburg, Russia

Built by Peter the Great and designed by Italian architects, St. Petersburg is truly a magical metropolis and considered Russia's window to the West. Boasting European sophistication with an imperial flair, whimsical golden spires, pastel-colored palaces and onion domes complement the city's vast network of canals and arched bridges.

Tallinn, Estonia

Culturally fascinating and beautifully preserved, Tallinn is the result of avant-garde style fused with medieval charm. Red-roofed homes line cobbled streets and 14th-century churches are ornamented by powerful spires. The Guild Houses, Baroque palaces, famed Apothecary shop and exquisite Town Hall await you in this legendary city.
