

- Tour of Serbia's historic capital of **Belgrade**, featuring the medieval city center, Kalemegdan Fortress and the Josip Broz Tito memorial.
- Excursion to the fascinating archaeological excavation at Lepinski Vir for insight into one of the oldest Danube cultures.
- Passage through the dramatic, naturally carved **Iron Gates** dividing the Carpathian and Balkan Mountains.
- Excursion to the village of Arbanasi, Bulgaria, known for its unique stone architecture, with visits to the Konstantsaliev House and the 15th-century Birth of Christ Church.
- Visit to the historic Bulgarian Empire capital of Veliko Târnovo, with lunch.
